Interviews and Application Dates

You apply in the academic year prior to the year you wish to start the course in. Foundation staff begin interviewing applicants in October and the course is usually full by late March. Therefore, to avoid disappointment, we recommend you apply in the Autumn Term or early in the Spring Term. We will not consider applicants after 30th June.

Applications should be made on this application form (either paper based or digitally) and sent directly to the above address. You do not apply for Foundation Courses through UCAS.

Entry Requirements

Applicants should normally hold at least one A-Level A2 qualification at grade C or above or a National Diploma/Extended National Diploma in a visual arts subject, plus 3 GCSE's at grade C or above. Applicants without a good grade for GCSE English Language may struggle with the written component of the course. Applicants must demonstrate at interview that they have the commitment and skills necessary to complete the course and the potential to subsequently gain a place on a reputable art and design degree course. Mature applicants may not necessarily have the preferred academic qualifications but must demonstrate art and design skills that are of A-Level standard. All applicants will be invited to interview with a portfolio of their work.
